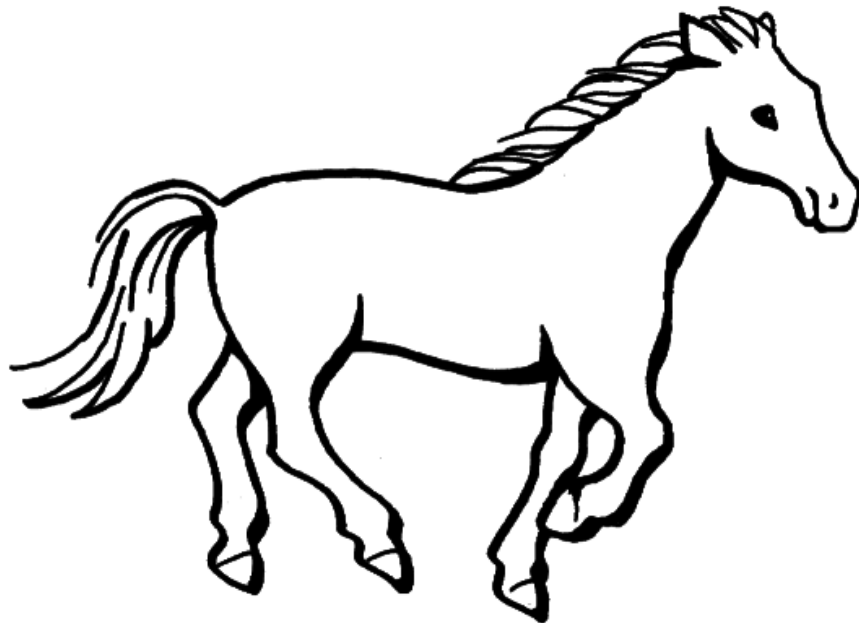


## Animal Friends
